The story

It started with a simple question: why are so many of us building alone?

Cagliari is full of entrepreneurs — founders, freelancers, consultants, creators, investors. People who moved here from somewhere else, or who grew up here and decided to build something of their own. For a long time, there was no obvious place to connect.

So we made one.

What began as a small gathering of curious founders has grown into a community of over 200 members from more than 15 nationalities — 22+ events across 16 venues, and 30+ guest entrepreneurs who've shared their journeys. And we're just getting started.

Why Sardinia
